

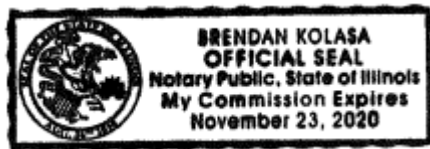

## PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with General Statutes § 16-50I and § 16-50I-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, notice is hereby given that Tarpon Towers, II, LLC ("Tarpon") will file an application with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council"). Tarpon will file an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need ("Application") for a proposed installation of a monopole wireless telecommunications facility ("Facility") to be located at 800 Prospect Hill Road, Windsor, Connecticut ("Property"). Tarpon will file the Application on or about November 13, 2020.

Tarpon proposes to construct the Facility, consisting of a 135 foot monopole structure on the Property, which would host an antenna array belonging to T-Mobile Northeast LLC, a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA Inc. d.b.a. T-Mobile ("T-Mobile"). The proposed Facility would provide reliable wireless communications services to underserved local roads and adjacent areas along the Day Hill Road Corridor, between Route 187 and Interstate 91, in the Town of Windsor ("Town"). The proposed Facility, in conjunction with other existing facilities, would increase user experience, including data rates and call quality in this area of the Town, as well as additional capacity relief to existing T-Mobile facilities. The Application will set forth the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and will also describe the environmental impact, if any, of the Facility.

Tarpon will conduct a balloon float at the proposed height and location of the Facility on the day of the Council's public hearing on the Application, as scheduled by the Council. The Council will provide notice of the public hearing date. The Council will conduct that public hearing in Windsor.
