While visiting the site today I noticed that the location of the sign posting has the potential to obstruct views of cars pulling out onto RT 37 from Coote Hill Rd. There was an accident just this am, not due to our sign, that took out the Coote Hill Rd street sign- you can see the tire marks in the grass of the car that barely missed our sign. It's a dangerous stretch known for many accidents. We are going to relocate the sign tomorrow further south on RT 37 as to avoid any obstruction of traffic views.
