Thank you for your email.

Your request for intervenor status will be taken up at the commencement of the evidentiary hearing session on Tuesday at 2 PM subject to any objection that may be submitted by the applicant. If the request is granted, you may cross examine the applicant on the exhibits they've submitted into the record (ex. application, pre-filed testimony, responses to interrogatories, etc.) and when it is time for your appearance, the applicant and the Council may cross examine you and your witness, Mr. Touroonjian, on the exhibits you've submitted into the record. We certainly do not expect you to submit your exhibits and pre-filed testimony by close of business today. After the hearing on Tuesday concludes, a revised schedule will be developed with a continued evidentiary hearing session date and deadlines for additional pre-filed testimony and interrogatories for all parties and intervenors in the proceeding.
