Good morning.

We are reviewing Mr. Greenbaum's filings on behalf of the Applicants and wish to notify the Council and Mr. Greenbaum that the Applicants may file a procedural motion with the Council with respect to same. As such, for the moment, we would ask that Mr. Greenbaum's documents not be uploaded to the Council's public website page for Docket 499 until we have had an opportunity to make certain objections or requests.

In this regard, we believe from a cursory review that some of the filed documents should 1) be placed in the public comment file, 2) subject to a protective order as proprietary though apparently disclosed by one party to a contract who is not a party to the proceeding, or 3) excluded as not relevant to the Council's statutory considerations in the Docket. We will endeavor to file any motion today with our intention of aiding the Council and Mr. Greenbaum in his pro se case procedurally and avoiding significant time at the start of the continued hearing next week on verbal motions.
