The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of your correspondence dated April 11, 2022, regarding compliance with the condition of the Council's March 14, 2022, Development and Management Plan (D&M) approval to provide a copy of the DEEP-issued Stormwater Permit for the above-referenced facility.

The Council acknowledges that the D&M Plan condition has been satisfied and that DEEP extended the tree clearing time period to April 15, 2022. This acknowledgment applies only to the D&M Plan condition satisfied by the April 11, 2022, correspondence. Requests for any changes to the D&M Plan shall be approved by Council staff in accordance with Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies (RCSA) §16-50j-77(b).

Please be advised that deviations from the Council's Decision and Order and D&M Plan approvals are enforceable under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50u. Furthermore, the Certificate Holder is responsible for reporting requirements pursuant to RCSA §16-50j-77.

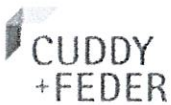
