Dear Attorney Bachman:


NAPP wishes to provide a potential resolution of the issue concerning “membership” of NAPP. NAPP is a domestic, non-profit association formed to promote conservation and natural beauty in the Town of Killingly, Connecticut (the “Town”); to protect the environment, health and biological values of the Town; to preserve historical sites; to promote consumer interests; to represent commercial and industrial groups; and to promote the orderly development of the Lake Road area of Killingly where NTE proposes to construct its 550 MW natural gas power plant. We are not aware of any law that requires a board, directors, or members for such an entity.

At the prehearing status conference held on September 28, 2016, staff for the Siting Council indicated that the public hearing to be conducted on October 20, 2016 is for the purpose of soliciting comment from non-parties and non-intervenors, Counsel for NTE raised an appropriate question – for purposes of the October 20, 2016 public hearing, how will the Siting Council know if a speaker at said meeting is not otherwise a party or intervenor? I have discussed this concern with individuals active with NAPP and propose a resolution. Assuming that NAPP is granted party status, prior to October 13, 2016, one week before the October 20 meeting, NAPP will provide the Siting Council and counsel for NTE with a list of the persons and companies who, for purposes of the hearings, are deemed to be members of NAPP. These persons and companies will not participate in the public hearing on October 20, but will be permitted to provide testimony and to otherwise participate in the hearings currently scheduled for November 3, November 15, and December 15, 2016, and any other administrative proceedings concerning Docket No. 470.


