On January 18, 2019, pursuant to the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes §4-181a(b), NTE Connecticut, LLC filed a Motion to Reopen and Modify the Connecticut Siting Council's (Council) May 11, 2017 decision to deny without prejudice a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to NTE Connecticut, LLC for the above-referenced, proposed electric generating facility and associated electrical interconnections in the Town of Killingly.

The Motion to Reopen and Modify the Council's May 11, 2017 decision will be placed on the Council meeting agenda scheduled for February 14, 2019 for Council consideration.
