JOINT REQUEST FOR ADMINISTRATIVE NOTICE

On March 3, 2017, the Connecticut Siting Council (the “Council”) reopened the evidentiary record in the above-referenced matter for the limited purpose of introducing evidence related to the results of the Forward Capacity Auction conducted by ISO-New England (ISO-NE) on February 6, 2017 (FCA 11) and scheduled an additional evidentiary hearing for this matter for March 23, 2017. On March 20, 2017, ISO-NE released its Draft 2017 CELT ISO-NE Annual Energy and Summer Peak Forecast, which provides the ISO’s most current forecasts of gross and net summer and winter load through 2026. Because these forecasts affect the level of capacity that the ISO will procure in future forward capacity auctions involving similar participants, they bear on the interpretation of the FCA 11 results. Not Another Power Plant, The Wyndham Land Trust, and Sierra Club respectfully request that the Council take administrative notice of ISO-NE’s Draft 2017 CELT ISO-NE Annual Energy and Summer Peak Forecast, which is available at https://www.iso-ne.com/static-assets/documents/2017/03/a2_new_england_energy_efficiency_pv_and_load_forecast_update.pdf.


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
