- 3. List the names, addresses and qualifications including the number of any vocational or professional license issued by the State of Connecticut, if any, of those individuals that the certificate holder and petitioner intend to have testify to the Connecticut Siting Council in support of Exhibit 1 and Exhibit 2 referenced by and made a part of submission of the Petition to Reopen and Modify of CPV Towantic LLC filed November 3, 2014.
- 4. Besides the Inland Energy Center in Riverside County, California (as cited in Tetra Tech "Environmental Overview" report Para. 2.1.1, page 5) where else in the United States has the proposed GE Frame 7H-Series operated?

- 5. With respect to the proposed GE Frame 7HA.01 turbines, list the location and total number of hours of operation in the six months prior to the date that CPV Towantic LLC filed its Petition to Reopen and Modify ie. March 3, 2014 November 2, 2014.

- 12. Explain the reason and difference in cost estimate for the "The single water storage tank [that is proposed to be changed to] two water storage tanks that are 42 feet tall."
- 13. Describe in detail the significant benchmarks of the proposed Facility in intervals of six months beginning in June 1, 2015 including an estimate of the schedule for financing, permitting and construction to allow the completion of the Project by the proposed extension of the construction deadline of June 1, 2019.
