- 6. What was the authority for that decision?
- 7. Please provide a copy of the original Town of Oxford Planning and Zoning Committee (TPZ) minutes at which the original application was approved.
- 8. Please provide a copy of the TPZ review of the original application.
- 9. How soon after this decision was made did Towantic Energy LLC apply to build a gas-fired electric generator in Oxford?
- 10. What was the wording of the 2001 referendum that approved the sale of 20 acres of town owned land to Towantic Energy LLC of Westport?
- 11. What was the vote on that referendum?
- 12. Was there an exception to the Zoning regulations made for the proposed power plant? If so, please provide the Planning and Zoning minutes that show this exception.
- 13. Has Inland Wetlands approved the proposed power plant site? If so, when? Is the permit still in effect? Please provide a copy of the permit.
