## MOTION FOR CONTINUATION OF THE PUBLIC HEARING

Town of Middlebury ("Middlebury"), docketed as a Party and an Intervenor, respectfully requests the Connecticut Siting Council schedule a public hearing at least sixty (60) day after the issuance of the written report of the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection to the applicant's submission dated September 8, 2014. The public hearings on the above-captioned Motion to Modify commencing January 15, 2015 and tentatively scheduled to continue on January 29, 2015 and certain dates in February 2015, subject to weather, are intended to provide necessary information to the Council, Parties, Intervenors, and general public. Critical in the Council's review process is balancing the issues of the application's environmental compatibility and public need. Middlebury has been unduly burdened and not been able to prepare properly and fully participate in the public hearing scheduled to date because of the partial and incomplete release of pertinent information pursuant to the schedule dated December 11, 2014 (the "Schedule"). As an original Party and responding Intervenor to the reopened proceedings, Middlebury is at a significant disadvantage in

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terms of anticipating the full scope of the November 3, 2014 Petition and any advance preparation to the filings with public agencies made throughout 2014.

Middlebury has yet been unable to select and retain experts based on the December 11, 2014 schedule providing less than one month to prepare Middlebury's pre-filed testimony simultaneous with receipt of the applicant's initial interrogatory responses to Middlebury and other Intervenors. Middlebury believes that if the Council does not extend the public hearing schedule as Middlebury requests, then Middlebury will be significantly prejudiced in its ability to present its case. Pursuant to Conn. Gen. Stat. §16-500, Middlebury "shall have the right to present such oral or documentary evidence and to conduct such cross-examination as may be required for a full and true disclosure of the facts." As it currently stands, the accelerated procedural schedule in this docket has not permitted Middlebury adequate time to develop its evidence with respect to this proceeding. If the Council denies Middlebury's request for an extension, Middlebury will be unable to provide adequate oral and documentary evidence that permits a full and true disclosure of the facts. Based on the applicant's request for additional time to construct the previously approved power plant and given that the conditions of the site have been virtually unchanged since the initial approval in 1999, no imminent harm will occur if the Council grants Middlebury's request here. Conversely, a denial of Middlebury's request for an extension would significantly prejudice Middlebury and all the Intervenors recently approved.

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WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons, Middlebury respectfully requests a sixty (60) day extension to the remaining items listed on Council's December 11, 2014 schedule in the above-referenced docket.
