

Please consider these issues/ facts prior to your decision to allow a request for an another extention or change of there original permit of November 21, 2002.

1. Multible renewables since 2002
2. Major changes such as 520 megawatts to 620 mg.
3. Public water changes I.E. City of Middletown
4. Oil supply changes, tanks , pipe lines.
5. Nevas Report- Investigation Review Panel- Using nitrogen to clean/purge did so on Jan. 28, 2010 not on Feb 7, 2010
6. Recommended to wait for THOMAS report.
7. Scores of OSHA violations. 16.6 million dollar penalty.
8. Have not settled clames responsalbe to neighboring property victums of the Feb. 7, 2010 BLAST.
9. SIX persons lost there lives/ many others injured.
10. Previous experience building gas fired power plants of this size.

Please consider these ten points as a base line to any other plant preveously built of the same type and size. Therefor under the laws of the state of CT I hereby request that the Siting Council DENY this request until all realavant materials and the THOMAS report become final.
