OBJECTION TO REQUEST FOR PARTY STATUS

The co-applicants, Optasite Towers LLC and Omnipoint Communications, Inc. (collectively the "Co-Applicants") respectfully submit this objection to a request for party status dated April 18, 2008 submitted by Karl Wagener of 588 Neipsic Road in Glastonbury ("Wagener"). In support of its objection, the Co-Applicants state as follows:

- This application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need was received by the Council on or about March 17, 2008 (the "Application").
- 2. On or about April 18, 2008, Wagener submitted a request for party status pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50n.
- 3. Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50n (a) states that the parties to a certificate proceeding shall include: (1) the applicant, certificate holder or petitioner; (2) each person entitled to receive a copy of the application under § 16-50l if such person files a notice of intent to be a party; (3) any domestic or qualified nonprofit corporation or association formed in whole

- or in part to promote conservation or natural beauty; and (4) any such other persons as the council may at any time deem appropriate.
- 4. Wagener does not fall under any of the categories listed in § 16-50n (a).
 In addition, Wagener is not nor does he allege to be an abutting property owner to either of the two alternate sites proposed in this Application.
- 5. As such, Wagener is more appropriately granted intervenor status pursuant to § 16-50n (b) and § 4-177a.

WHEREFORE, the Co-Applicants respectfully object to Wagener's request for party status and request that the Council grant Wagener intervenor status in this docket.
