Dear Chairman Caruso:

We are the residents that reside at 14 Indian Spring Road, and we are opposed to the construction of a 140' cell tower proposed at 52 Stadley Rough Road. We oppose the proposed cell tower and support the efforts of the Core Group of Residents and the City of Danbury on our behalf.

Our house is set back from the road with a long driveway that winds around the front of the house in a circular driveway. Our lot has been cleared of trees close to the property border; front, back and side yards. Because our house is set so far back from the road and there are no other structures adjacent to our lot, we have a lot of privacy. If the tower is constructed, depending on its final location, it could be a little more than 40' from our property line and will be in visual site from our entire 3.5 acre plot.

We spent a considerable amount of money when built our house, installed our pool, and landscaped our lot prior to the first proposed cell tower hearing in May 2006. In addition to real estate devaluation, we also have safety concerns. We have two young children and installed a built-in pool in our back yard that our children and family members use throughout the spring and summer months.
