Additional Information Regarding Subsurface Sewage Disposal System

52 Stadley Rough Road Optasite Towers LLC

As requested by Chairman Caruso of the Connecticut Siting Council at the hearing on January 26, 2009, I have calculated the approximate land area covered by the existing subsurface sewage disposal system serving Christ the Sheppard Church at 52 Stadley Rough Road. The source of the data is the City of Danbury Health Department septic system file for 52 Stadley Rough Road.

- According to information found in the file, the primary leaching system portion of the subsurface sewage disposal system is located approximately 110 feet west of the church building. The existing leaching area measures approximately 60 feet by 130 feet covering 7,800 square feet.
- The size and location of the required code-complying reserve area is yet to be determined. The property owner must submit to the City of Danbury Health Department for a "B100a Review". The submission should include a site plan showing all proposed construction activities, existing above and below ground structures (including cell tower and related improvements), estimated daily sewage flows and a codecomplying reserve area location, including results of the required soil testing performed in that location.

The Statements above are true and complete to the best of my knowledge.
