
Dear Ms Nappier:

Pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50(bb), please be advised that the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) is in receipt of the sum of \$25,000 as payment to the Municipal Participation Account in connection with the above-referenced proceeding. This payment was received on October 20, 2008, and deposited into your department account (OTT14420) in fund 12060 – “Other Restricted Revenue”.

Section (b) of the Statutes states, in part, that “[p]ayments from the account shall be made upon authorization by the State Treasurer...” and provides guidance in the event an application involves more than one municipality. To that end, please note that the above-referenced proceeding required notice be sent to 8 municipalities. A list of these municipalities is enclosed herewith for your review. Any or all of the municipalities listed may apply for a portion of the Fund. Proof of said expenditures will be required by the Office of the State Treasurer.


