

ISO New England Inc. (the "ISO") of One Sullivan Road, Holyoke,
Massachusetts 01040, hereby requests that the Connecticut Siting Council (the
"Council") grant it intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding pursuant to
Section 16-50n and Section 4-177a of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-
50j-15a of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

The ISO, a private, non-profit corporation which serves as the independent system
operator of the New England bulk power grid and as the regional transmission

organization for the New England region, is requesting intervenor status in the above-captioned proceeding because it has substantial interests that may be affected by the proceeding. The ISO is responsible for the day-to-day reliable operation of the New England region's bulk electric generation and transmission system and is charged by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to plan for and ensure a reliable bulk power system for New England. The proposed transmission projects and related improvements involve the Connecticut portion of a larger project known as the Greater Springfield Reliability Project ("GSRP") which is in turn part of the New England East-West Solution ("NEEWS"), an overall transmission-based solution to electric system reliability needs in Connecticut, Massachusetts and Rhode Island. The outcome of this proceeding will therefore significantly affect the reliability of the electric system in these states and more broadly in New England, and the ISO therefore has significant interests at stake in this proceeding.


The ISO requests intervenor status in this docket in order to monitor the proceedings by receiving filings and notices from the Council, the applicant and other parties and intervenors. The ISO may also participate in the proceeding by filing written testimony, presenting expert witnesses and by cross-examining witnesses. The ISO's unique expertise in the area of electric generation, transmission, system reliability, and bulk power system operation planning and operation will assist the Council in resolving issues in this docket and will not impair the orderly conduct of the proceedings.


