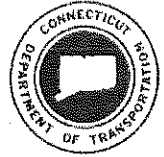

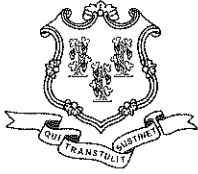
RE: **DOCKET NO. -370B** -NRG Energy, Inc. application pursuant to C.G.S. 16-50/(a)(3)  
for consideration of a 530MW combined cycle generating plant in Meriden, Connecticut.

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The Department of Transportation (D.O.T.) has reviewed the above mentioned Docket and has the following comment.

1.) If the proposed project requires access to Route 9 or would require any work within the Route 9 right of way, or state routes then the applicant must obtain an encroachment permit pursuant to the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, Section 13b-17-1. The District 1 Permit office will need to review a complete set of construction plans which show all work within the highway, all site work, maintenance and protection of traffic, any required easements and standard details for highway construction prior to issuing the permit.

The District 1 Permit Office will determine the bond amount, insurance coverage, maintenance and protection of traffic, inspection, roadway restoration and pavement restoration requirements.
