

Pre-Hearing Interrogatories, Set Two

1. Provide a diagram that depicts the site property in its entirety.
2. Is AT&T amenable to installing a monopole with a flush-mounted antenna design? Describe how a flush mount antenna design would affect coverage, future equipment needs, and potential tower sharing. Provide coverage plots if necessary.
3. Is the property owner amenable to installing the tower in other locations on the property? If so, identify these locations.
4. Are there other towers or tall structures in the area (2 mile radius) that do not support AT&T's equipment? If so, please identify the structure, height of structure, address and structure location on a map.
5. What is the height of the existing church steeple? Was the existing steeple or an enlarged steeple considered for telecommunications use?
