are sandy and would make a good substrate for nesting turtles. The current problem with this area for a nesting site is that the trees block out most of the sun. This tree line that borders the brook will most likely not be disrupted during the project. Further up the brook, the adjacent property is a backyard to a house. The backyard of this house looks like favorable nesting habitat. I spoke to one of the residence from this property and they confirmed that in fact this past summer they had more than one turtle try to nest in their yard and these turtles were returned back to the brook with the use of a shovel. The description of these turtles did not fit the description of Box Turtles (Terrapene Carolina) but rather they were most likely Snapping Turtles (Chelydra serpentina)

If this project is approved, depending on how may trees are removed this could open up the canopy and let the sun nit the ground and may open up some nesting spots for any turtles in the area. Since this site is in close proximity to a brook, a silt fence will most likely be used. This silt fence will help keep any wondering turtles out of harms way.
