Youghiogheny Communications-Northeast, LLC, doing business as Pocket Communications' ("Pocket") hereby submits this letter in response to the motion to reopen filed by the applicant, AT&T and the Siting Council's ruling permitting the reopening and scheduling a hearing on June 29, 2010. Pocket's understanding of this reopening is that it is limited to the environmental impacts associated with the slight repositioning of the proposed facility at 224 Lovely Street.

Pocket again confirms its need for this site and confirms that, at the revised location, it has a need to locate 3 antennas at 90 feet AGL. Pocket can accomplish this by either exterior flush mounts or by internal flush mounts. Given the limited issues being considered on June 29, 2010, Pocket does not intend to attend the hearing on June 29, 2010. If the Council or any party or intervenor require additional information from Pocket or believe that Pocket's attendance is necessary on June 29th, please let me know prior to June 21, 2010 so that Pocket can arrange for the appropriate representation for the same.
