

RE: **DOCKET NO. 379** – SBA Towers II, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located at 12 Burr Road, Bloomfield, Connecticut.

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) notes that the Applicant's late-file exhibit (response) to the question that was the subject of the Council's July 13, 2009, post-hearing memorandum (dated July 14, 2009) was received by the Council on Thursday, July 16, 2009. In consideration of the Applicant's providing this response earlier than the July 24, 2009, the date that was required, and in an effort to avoid undue delays, the Council announces that the post-hearing comment period, required under the provisions of C.G.S. Sec.16-50n(f), will expire on Friday, August 14, 2009. Thus, any person who has not become a party or intervenor, but who desires to make his or her views known to the Council, may file written statements with the Council by close-of-business, Friday, August 14, 2009.

The Council also notes that, pursuant to the provisions of C.G.S. Sec.16-50p(a)(2)(c), the current date by which the Council must render a decision in this matter is (Sunday) September 13, 2009 (read: Monday, September 14, 2009). Because of the Council's workload and other scheduling limitations, the Council does not anticipate being able to render a decision by this date. Therefore, pursuant to the same statutory provisions, the Council hereby requests an additional 60 day extension to Friday, November 13, 2009. We thank you in advance for your timely response to this matter.
