A. As discussed in SBA Exhibit 1 at Exhibit I, in the pre-filed testimony of Ms. Hollis Redding and during the public hearing on July 9, 2009, SBA had submitted a proposal for a telecommunications facility at Auer Farm. In the spring of 2008, Auer Farm indicated to SBA that it was not interested in pursuing such a proposal. The representatives of Auer Farm did not give any reasons for their rejection of SBA's proposal.
