AT&T RESPONSES TO PRE-HEARING INTERROGATORIES, SET TWO

- Q1. Provide coverage plots, at the same scale, showing only coverage from the proposed site with AT&T antennas at 150 feet agl and 140 feet agl.
- A1. Included as attachment 1 please find two plots depicting only coverage from the proposed site with AT&T antennas at 140 feet agl and 150 feet agl.
- Q2. What are the approximate distances from the proposed site to the sites identified as S1876 (24 Dinglebrook Lane in Southbury [*sic* Newtown]) and S1860 (in Roxbury)?
- A2. AT&T's radio frequency engineers calculate the distance from the proposed site to Site 1876 as approximately 2.45 miles and to Site 1860 as approximately 3.19 miles.



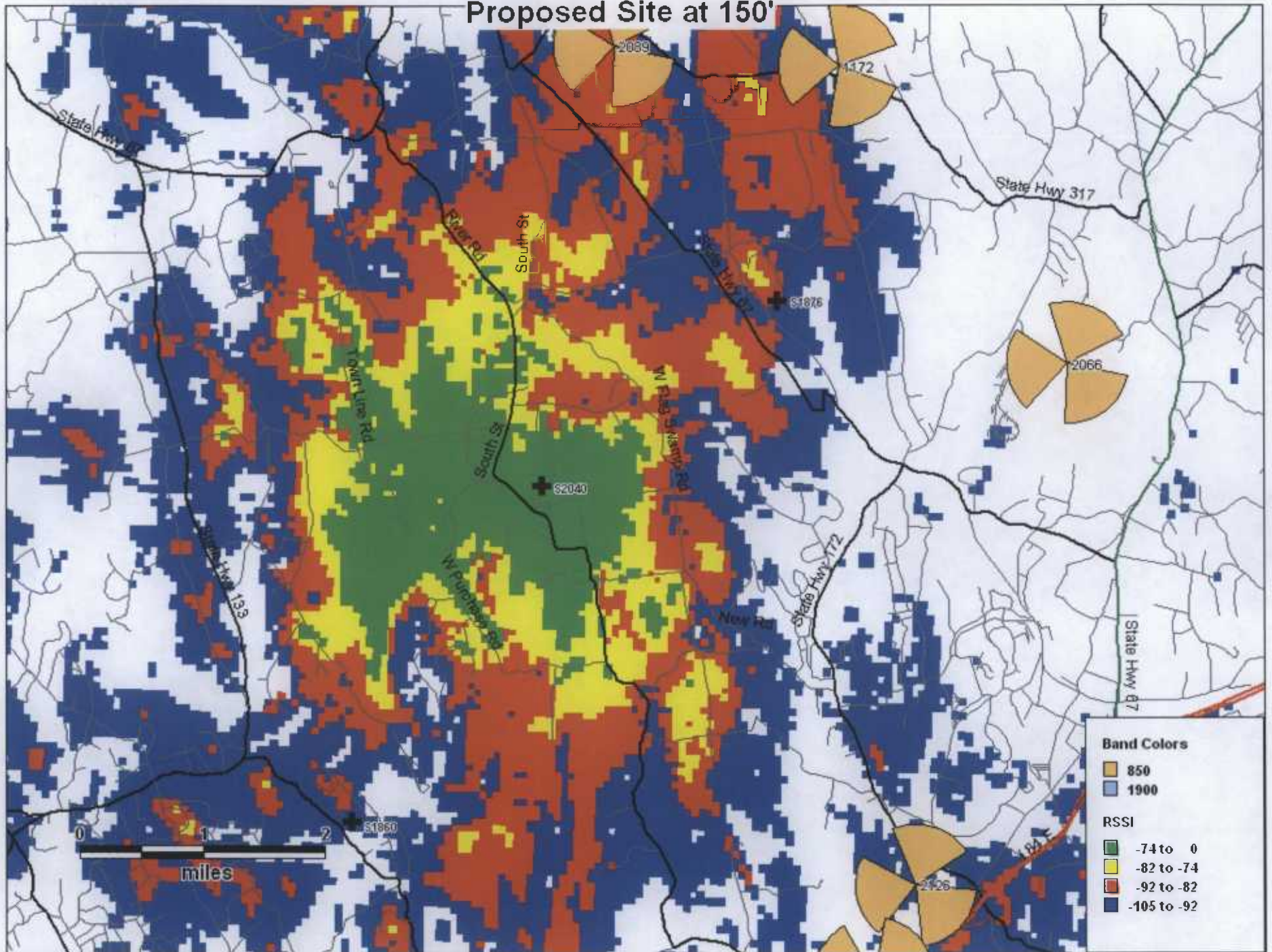
