
















TO USE MAP

Locate project boundaries and any additional affected areas on the map. If the project is not within a shaded area, or overlapping a lake, pond, or wetland that has any shading or upland or downland dry wet from the area, the project may be in an area that is potentially sensitive to listed species or significant natural community. If any part of the project is within a shaded area, or overlapping a lake, pond, or wetland that has any shading or upland or downland dry wet from the area, the project may have potential conflict with a sensitive natural community. Consult a Data Base Review Form and the Natural Diversity Data Base with a project biologist, and a copy of a map study showing the project location.

DATA SOURCES

BASE MAP INFORMATION - Political boundaries, railroads, and hydrography originally derived from 1:24,000 scale 23N6000 U.S. Geological Survey digital line graphs and administered by the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. The data is based on 1:24,000 scale Topographic Overlays maps published between 1989 and 1998. The names and road names are credited to the U.S. Geological Survey. The data is based on U.S. Geological Survey Geographic Information System and information on file at the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection. The base map data may be revised correct for changes.

***NODS INFORMATION** - Locations of listed species and natural communities are based on data collected by the CT Department of Environmental Protection, private conservation groups and the scientific community and compiled by the Natural Diversity Data Base. The information is not necessarily the result of on-site visits or site-specific field investigations. In some cases locations have been derived from literature or museum searches or historic records. Exact locations have been buffered to produce generalized locations. The exact species or community location data are not shown within the shaded areas and not necessarily in the center.
