AFFIDAVIT OF RAYMOND M. VERGATI

- I, Raymond M. Vergati, do hereby declare and state:
- 1. I am over the age of 18 years, and believe in the obligation of an oath.
- 2. I am the vice president of operations of HPC Development, LLC ("HPC") with respect to projects in New England.
- 3. HPC has overseen the development of the telecommunications facility proposed by T-Mobile Northeast, LLC ("T-Mobile") at 123 Pine Orchard Road, Branford, Connecticut (the "Facility"). I assisted in all facets of the site acquisition and have personal knowledge of the development of the Facility including the specific contents of this affidavit.
- 4. I communicated with representatives of the National Railroad Passenger Corporation ("Amtrak") on several occasions about the possibility of co-locating T-Mobile's wireless equipment on the catenaries along the Amtrak rail line right of way in Connecticut.
- On or about August 1, 2008, I spoke to Brian S. Webster, Project Director
 with Amtrak Real Estate Development, via telephone to discuss the possibility of T-

Mobile co-locating its equipment and antennae on Amtrak's catenaries in Connecticut, including the Town of Branford.

- 6. Amtrak maintains a policy in which it prohibits wireless providers from colocating their equipment and antennae on Amtrak catenaries along the northeast corridor, north of New York City. This policy is based upon structural and safety concerns. (*Please see Webster email attached hereto as Exhibit A.*)
- 7. Because of Amtrak's policy, co-locating on the Amtrak catenaries is not a viable alternative to the proposed Facility.
- 8. I have also spoken with representatives of Clearwire Communications ("Clearwire"). Clearwire is also interested in co-locating on the Facility at a height of 92'9" above grade level ("AGL"). (Please see Clearwire email attached hereto as Exhibit B.)
- 9. I have also spoken with representatives of Youghiogheny Communications Northeast, LLC d/b/a Pocket Wireless ("Pocket"). Pocket is interested in co-locating on the Facility at a height of 102'9" AGL.
