I have and thank you for your letter of September 24, 2009 concerning the above application.

On October 14, 2009, Kevin Dey and Attorney Daniel M. Laub gave a presentation on behalf of AT&T as to the proposed Wireless Telecommunication Tower Facility to be located at 1990 Litchfield Turnpike, Woodbridge CT.

Following the presentation, several residents of Woodbridge spoke either in opposition or with reservations about the application. A summary of their testimony is enclosed. I am also enclosing copies of written correspondence received by the Board of Selectmen prior to AT&T's presentation for your review.

Following the public comments, the Board of Selectmen voted unanimously to inform the Siting Council that it should explore alternative locations for a proposed tower other than the proposed site such as:

- 1. Look at moving away from chosen location
- 2. If tower must be near chosen location, consider installing antenna on other structures in the area such as:
