

## **MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER**

Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Cellco") and Message Center Management, Inc. ("MCM") respectfully request that the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") issue a Protective Order pursuant to Connecticut General Statutes section 1-210(b)(5), with respect to certain terms of the Land Lease Agreement, dated May 18, 2009, between Howard M. Schwager and Cellco (the "Site 1 Agreement") and the Purchase and Sale Agreement, dated June 20, 2008, between Joseph L. A. Robert and Homer Scoville and MCM (the "Site 2 Agreement") submitted to the Council in connection with the above-referenced proceeding.

Connecticut General Statutes section 16-500 provides, in relevant part:

The applicant shall submit into the record the full text of the terms of any agreement . . . entered into by the applicant . . . in connection with the construction or operation of the facility. This provision shall *not* require the disclosure of proprietary information or trade secrets.

Conn. Gen. Stat. § 16-50o(c) (emphasis added). Pursuant to this requirement, Cellco submitted redacted copies of the Site 1 Agreement and the Site 2 Agreement to the Council in the Docket No. 389 Application. *See* Application, Tabs 16 and 17. The redacted provisions relate to

financial terms and other confidential information contained in each agreement ("Confidential Information"). Cellco and MCM are willing to submit unredacted copies of the Site 1

Agreement and Site 2 Agreement to the Council subject to the issuance of a Protective Order that would limit disclosure of the Confidential Information to the Council and its staff.

As reflected in the attached Affidavit of Alexandria M. Carter, Regulatory Manager for Cellco and Maria A. Scotti, Director of MCM, the information for which Cellco and MCM seek protected treatment is commercially valuable, confidential and proprietary, market-sensitive information that constitutes trade secrets within the meaning of Connecticut General Statutes §1-210(b)(5), and which Cellco and MCM have heretofore used its best efforts to maintain as secret in order to avoid the harm that would result if the information were to become publicly available. The Council has historically granted protected treatment of similar filings.

WHEREFORE, Cellco and MCM respectfully request that the Council grant the request for protected treatment consistent with the attached Protective Order for the Site 1 Agreement and the Site 2 Agreement, which would limit disclosure of the Confidential Information to the Council and its staff.
