


SIGN POSTING AFFIDAVIT

I, Michael Libertine, being duly sworn, deposes and states that:

1. I am over eighteen years of age and I understand the obligations of a statement under oath.
2. I am the Director of Environmental Services for Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. (“VHB”).
3. VHB has been working closely with the Docket No. 389 applicant, Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless in its application to construct a telecommunications facility at one of two locations off Dayton Road in Glastonbury, Connecticut.
4. Under my direction and supervision, VHB was responsible for the posting of two separate “Public Notice Signs” at the designated Site 1 and Site 2 locations off Dayton Road. In accordance with Connecticut Siting Council (“Council”) guidelines, the signs were posted on January 4, 2010, more than ten (10) business days prior to the scheduled public hearing on January 21, 2010.

The text of the posted notice is as set forth in the Council’s Telecommunications Facility Application Guide. 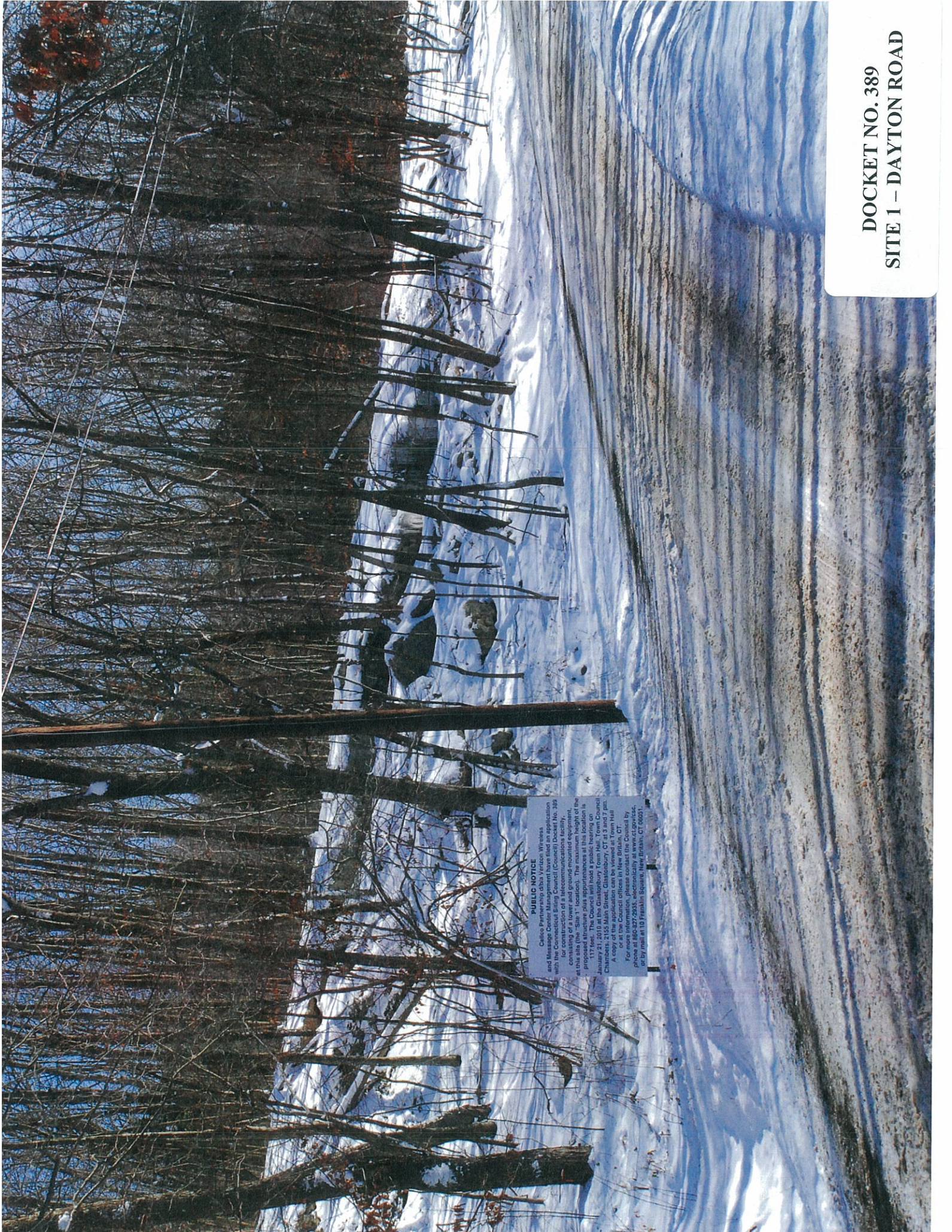

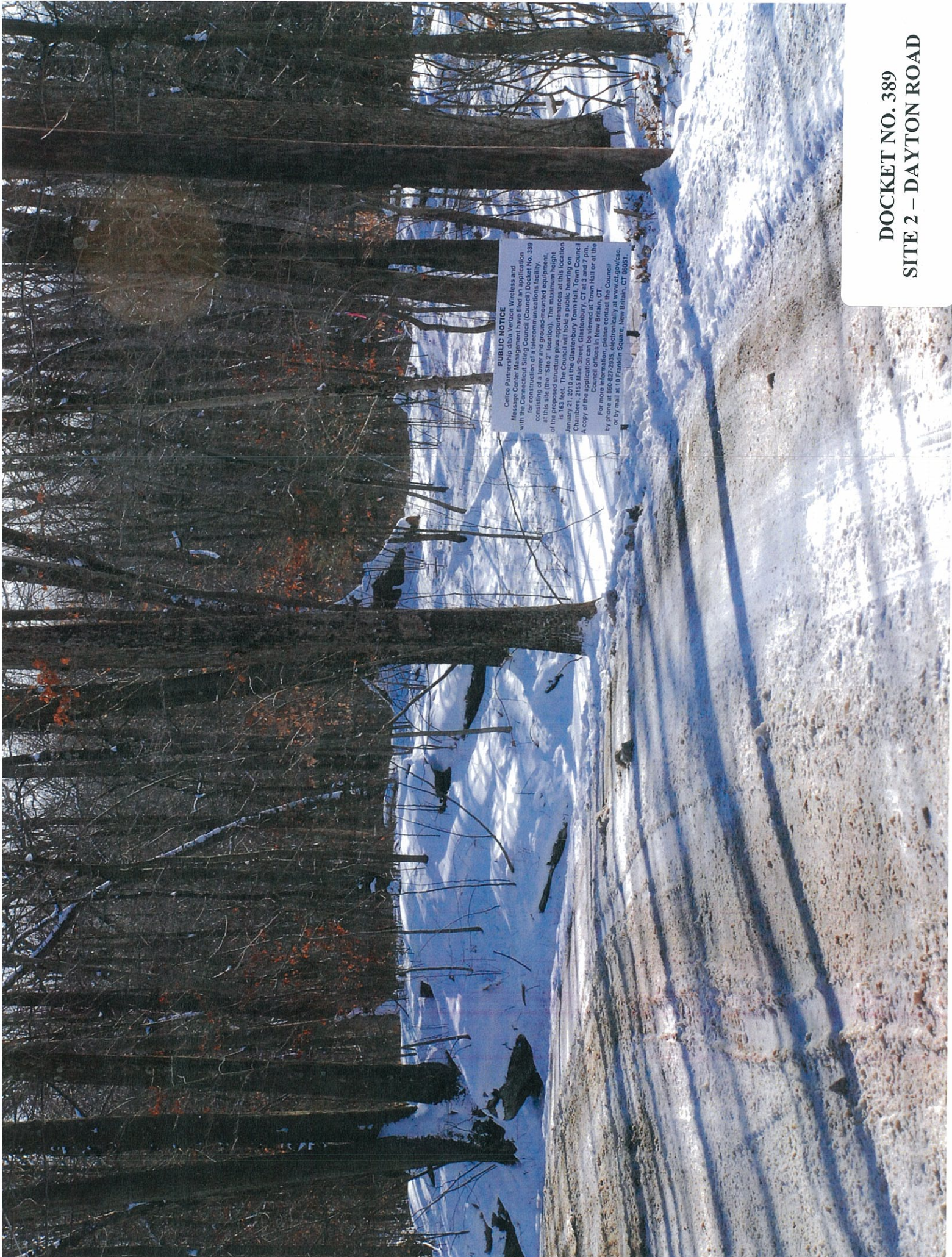
