RE: **DOCKET NO. 391** - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 232 Shore Drive, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

DOCKET NO. 392 - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 387 Shore Road, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

DOCKET NO. 393 - T-Mobile Northeast, LLC application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a telecommunications facility located 61-1 Buttonball Road, Old Lyme, Connecticut.

The Connecticut Siting Council (Council) shall continue the evidentiary hearing for the above-referenced dockets at 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 20, 2010, at Central Connecticut State University, Institute of Technology and Business Development, 185 Main Street, New Britain, Connecticut. The hearing will begin with Docket No. 391, followed by Docket Nos. 392 and 393 if time remains.

On or before March 19, 2010, all parties and intervenors may exchange/submit interrogatories for all three dockets. On or before April 13, 2010, all parties and intervenors shall submit their pre-filed testimony for all three dockets. Furthermore, any outstanding late filed exhibits, including but not limited to the Distributed Antenna System studies assigned to the applicant, shall be submitted on or before April 13, 2010.

In addition, during the Docket No. 392 portion of hearing, Mary Staley may put on her direct case. The Council will also rule on any outstanding objections at the hearing such as the admission of Mary Staley's exhibits.

With respect to Docket No. 393, briefs on the appropriateness of granting intervenor status to the Black Hall Club under the Connecticut Environmental Protection Act (CEPA) are due no later than April 2, 2010. The Council will also rule on any outstanding objections at the hearing such as the Black Hall Club intervenor request. The Black Hall Club may put on its direct case at that time.

**Directions to:
Institute of Technology and Business Development
Central Connecticut State University
185 Main Street New Britain, CT 06051**

From I-84 East (Waterbury)

Exit 35 (left exit) onto Route 72 East. Take third exit, marked Main Street. At the end of the exit take a right and travel one block to Chestnut Street. Turn right onto Chestnut Street and travel one block to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

From I-84 West (Hartford)

Exit 39A onto Route 9 South. Take Exit 27 - Chestnut Street (left exit). At the end of the exit take a right onto Chestnut Street and proceed through the second light to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

From South (Route 9, 91, or 15)

Travel north on Route 9 to Exit 26 (Downtown New Britain Exit). Go straight at the end of the exit and left at the second traffic light onto Chestnut Street. Go through one traffic light to Main Street. Turn right onto Main Street and ITBD is one block on the right.

Municipal Parking Garage (Chestnut Street):

Short-term visitor parking is located in the ITBD building garage. Long-term parking is available in the Municipal Parking garage on Chestnut Street.
