Dear Mr. Phelps:

I write regarding the ruling of the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on the objection ("Objection") by the Applicant, T-Mobile Northeast LLC ("T-Mobile") to the Black Hall Club's ("BHC") Request for Administrative Notice, dated February 22, 2010 ("Request"). T-Mobile respectfully requests a clarification of the Council's ruling on the Objection.

The Request included six requests for administrative notice. T-Mobile objected to requests one through five. T-Mobile did not object to request six.

In its ruling dated April 22, 2010, the Council stated that "[d]uring the continued evidentiary hearing held on April 20, 2010, T-Mobile withdrew its objection." T-Mobile, however, withdrew its objection because the BHC affirmatively withdrew requests one through five of the Request. The Objection was rendered moot. (*Transcript April 20, 2010, pp. 19-21.*)

T-Mobile respectfully requests that the Council clarify its ruling to indicate that the BHC affirmatively withdrew requests one through five of the Request. T-Mobile also requests that the ruling indicate that requests one through five are not included in the record.
