PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-501 and § 16-501-1 of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, notice is hereby given that Omnipoint Communications, Inc., a subsidiary of T-Mobile USA, Inc. d.b.a. T-Mobile ("T-Mobile") will file an application with the Connecticut Siting Council (the "Council"). T-Mobile will file an application for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a wireless communications facility at 61-1 Buttonball Road, Old Lyme, Connecticut (the "Application"). T-Mobile will file the Application on or about July 29, 2009. T-Mobile seeks to construct a new 100 foot, self-supporting monopole tower, with antennae, associated equipment and other site improvements necessary for the proposed facility (the "Facility"). The location, height and other features of the Facility are subject to review and change by the Council pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50g et seq.

The Facility will provide wireless service in the Town of Old Lyme, specifically along Buttonball Road, Route 156 and the nearby Amtrak Rail Line as well as in adjacent areas. The Application will set forth the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and will also describe the environmental impact, if any, of the Facility.

T-Mobile will conduct a balloon float at the proposed height of the Facility on the day of the public hearing on the Application as scheduled by the Council. The Council will provide notice of the public hearing date. The Council will conduct that public hearing in Old Lyme. The balloon float will take place between 1:00p.m. and 6:00p.m. or as set by the Council.
