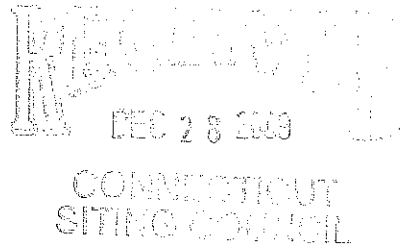



**LEGAL NOTICE**

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50f(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Regulations pertaining thereto, of an Application to be submitted to the Connecticut Siting Council ("Council") on or about December 9, 2009, by Celco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless ("Celco" or the "Applicant"). The Application proposes the installation of a wireless telecommunications facility in the Town of Woodstock, Connecticut. The installation would consist of a 100' x 100' leased area and a 50' x 75' fenced compound on an approximately 44 acre parcel owned by Frederick C., Barbara P., Frederick C. Jr. and Kimberly Rich. At this site, Celco proposes to construct a 130-foot monopole tower. Access to the site will extend from Prospect Street to the cell site, a distance of approximately 345 feet. Celco will also install fifteen (15) antennas at the 130-foot level and a new 12' x 30' shelter located near the base of the tower to house its radio equipment and a back-up generator. The location and other features of the proposed facility are subject to change under provisions of Connecticut General Statutes § 16-50g et. seq.

On the day selected for the Siting Council public hearing on this proposal, Celco will fly a balloon at the height of the proposed tower. Interested parties and residents of the Town of Woodstock are invited to review the Application during normal business hours at any of the following offices:

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
