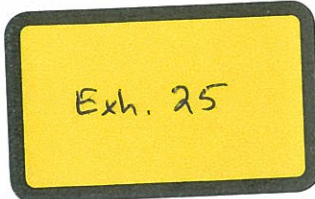

Re: **Docket No. 397 – Application of Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Construction, Maintenance and Operation of a Wireless Telecommunications Facility at 445 Prospect Street, Woodstock, Connecticut**

Dear Mr. Walker and Dr. Gordon:

As you know, on April 22, 2010, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless (“Cellco”) filed information with the Siting Council regarding, among other things, a third alternative tower location in the easterly portion of the Rich property. This third alternative location (identified as Alternate Site Location B), could satisfy Cellco’s coverage objectives in the area with a tower of 160 feet in height.

Shortly, the Siting Council will be publishing a Field Review Notice in the *Woodstock Villager* announcing a field review at the new alternate site on May 24, 2010, beginning at 2:00 p.m. The Council has asked Cellco to fly a balloon at the Alternate Site Location B at 160 feet to simulate the height of this alternate tower. Council members will also walk the access road and visually inspect the Alternate Site Location B. Additional information regarding the proposed alternate location will be discussed at the continuation of the public hearing on Docket No. 397 scheduled for May 27, 2010, at 2:00 p.m. at the Central Connecticut State University,
