16 BELL ROAD EXTENSION

From New Britain

Follow Route 9 north to Interstate 84 west. Follow directions from Hartford below.

From Hartford

Follow I-84 west to Exit 39, Route 4. Follow Route 4 west to Torrington. Follow directions from Waterbury below.

From Waterbury

Follow Route 8 north to Exit 44 in Torrington, Route 4.

Follow Route 4 west through Goshen and into Cornwall.

After intersection with Route 125, go approximately 0.6 miles and bear right onto Popple Swamp Road. (Turn is after Peirce Road).

Follow Popple Swamp Road for approximately 1 mile.

Bell Road Extension is on right at a dirt road turnoff.

TO HEARING: CORNWALL TOWN HALL

From Site

From Site - follow Popple Swamp Road back to Route 4.

Turn left onto Route 4.

Take first right on Jewell Street and immediately bear left at Y intersection onto Bolton Hill Road.


At end, go straight into Town Hall parking lot.
