At a meeting held on September 18, 2014 the Connecticut Siting Council ("CSC") approved the Transfer of Certificate to Construction Services of Branford. Blue Sky Towers, LLC ("Blue Sky") has recently acquired the wireless telecommunications facility that the Council approved in the above referenced docket.
