

1. Did Cellco receive return receipts for all adjacent landowners listed in Application Attachment 5? If not, describe any additional effort to serve notice.
2. Would blasting be required for the construction of the proposed site? Provide estimates of cut and fill.
3. What is Cellco's minimum signal level threshold for in-building and in-vehicle use?
4. What is the current signal strength in the proposed service area?
5. Provide a coverage plot, using the scale and thresholds in Application Attachment 7, that depict coverage from existing/approved Cellco sites and the proposed tower at a height of 100 feet.
6. Provide the methodology and input parameters used to obtain the power density figure presented on page 16 of the application.
7. Is the site within the *Upper Housatonic Valley National Heritage Area*? If so, describe the impact of the proposed facility on resources within the heritage area.
