### **TO FIELD REVIEW**

#### **Via Interstate 84 (Waterbury)**

Follow I-84 to Exit 10.  
At end of ramp, turn right onto Route 6 west.  
Follow Route 6 west to top of hill at flagpole.  
Turn left onto Route 25 south.  
Turn right onto Route 302 west (traffic light).  
Follow Route 302 west to Route 58 south (traffic light).  
Turn left onto Route 58 south and follow to Route 107.  
Turn right onto Route 107 south and follow past school, town hall and police station.  
After Route 107 curves, turn right onto Great Oak Lane (after Redding Nursery).  
Turn right at Highway Department driveway at 28 Great Oak Lane.

#### **Via Interstate 95 (Fairfield) and Merritt Parkway (Bridgeport)**

From Interstate 95, take Exit 23 for Route 135.  
Follow Route 135 north to Route 58 north (Black Rock Tpk.)

From Merritt Parkway, take Exit 44 for Route 58.

Follow Route 58 north to Redding Ridge – stop sign with white church on corner.  
Turn left onto Cross Highway.  
Follow Cross Highway through Redding village to end (at stop sign).  
Continue straight onto Route 107 south.  
Take first right onto Great Oak Lane.  
Turn right at Highway Department driveway at 28 Great Oak Lane.

## **TO COMMUNITY CENTER (37 Lonetown Road)**

### **From Site**

From Highway Department, turn left on Great Oak Lane.  
Turn left onto Route 107 and proceed approx. 0.7 miles.  
Turn left into Community Center Driveway on left (after Elementary School).  
Follow driveway past tennis courts to Community Center.

### **From Interstate 84 (Waterbury)**

Follow I-84 to Exit 10.  
At end of ramp, turn right onto Route 6 west.  
Follow Route 6 west to top of hill at flagpole.  
Turn left onto Route 25 south.  
Turn right onto Route 302 west (traffic light).  
Follow Route 302 west to Route 58 south (traffic light).  
Turn left onto Route 58 south and follow to Route 107.  
Turn right onto Route 107 south.  
Turn right into Community Center/School complex.  
Follow driveway past tennis courts to Community Center.

### **Via Interstate 95 (Fairfield) and Merritt Parkway (Bridgeport)**

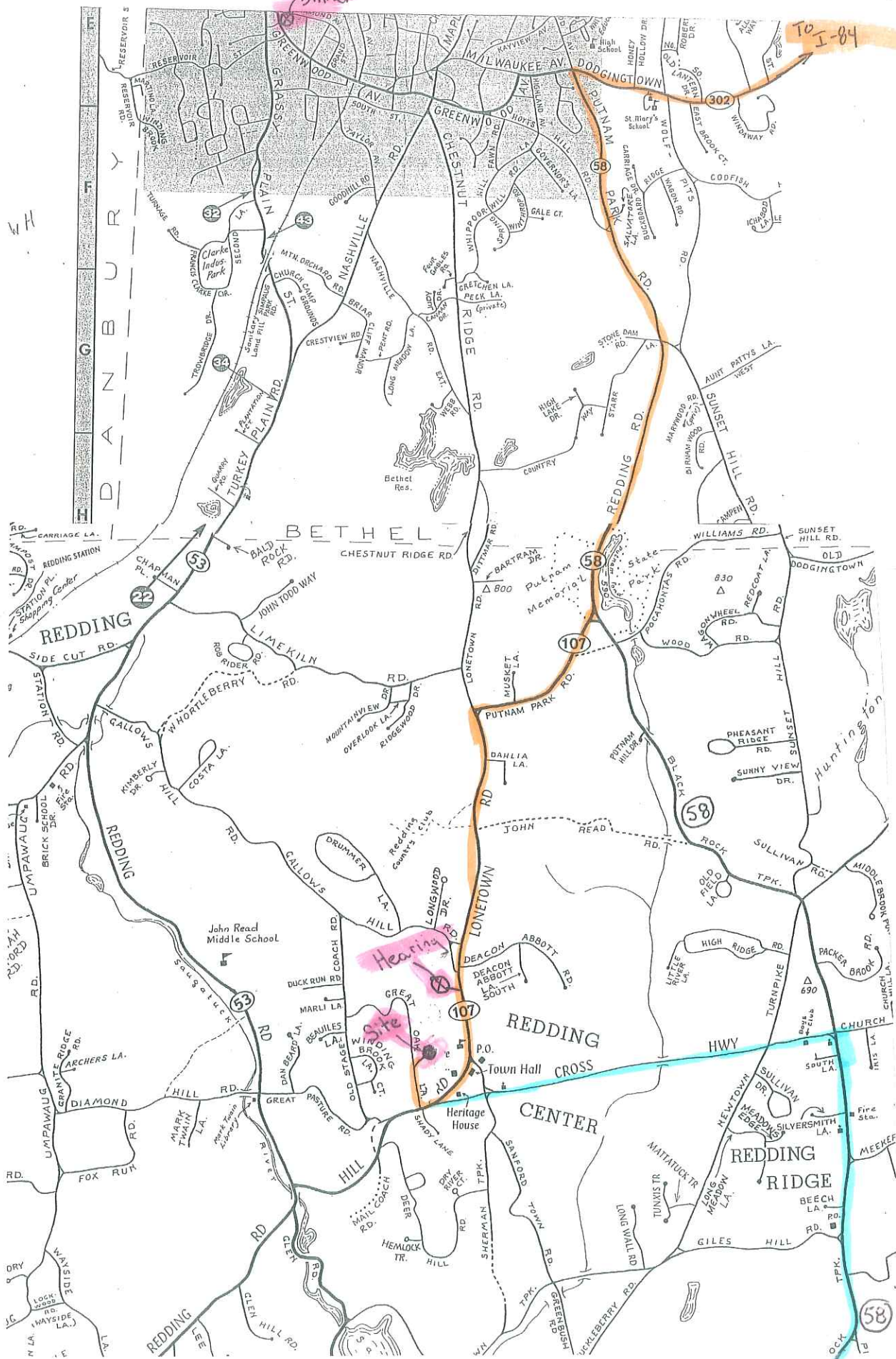
From Interstate 95, take Exit 23 for Route 135.  
Follow Route 135 north to Route 58 north (Black Rock Tpk.)

From Merritt Parkway, take Exit 44 for Route 58.

Follow Route 58 north to Redding Ridge – stop sign with white church on corner.  
Turn left onto Cross Highway.  
Follow Cross Highway through Redding village to end (at stop sign).  
Turn right onto Route 107 and proceed approx. 0.5 mile.  
Turn left into Community Center Driveway on left (after Elementary School).  
Follow driveway past tennis courts to Community Center

## **TO DINNER                      Whitlock's, 273 Route 302, Bethel**

Turn left onto Route 107 and follow to stop sign.  
Continue straight on Lonetown Road (Route 107 turns right).  
Bear left at first Y intersection in 0.7 miles, staying on Lonetown Road (Dittmar Road goes right).  
Lonetown Road turns into Chestnut Ridge Road, passing Dittmar Road again  
Bear right at second Y intersection, following Chestnut Ridge Road (Nashville Road bears left)  
After Y, continue straight for 1.5 miles to stop sign, proceed straight, and then turn left onto Route 302 at traffic light.  
Follow Route 302 for 0.8 miles.  
Whitlock's is on right after Burger King.
