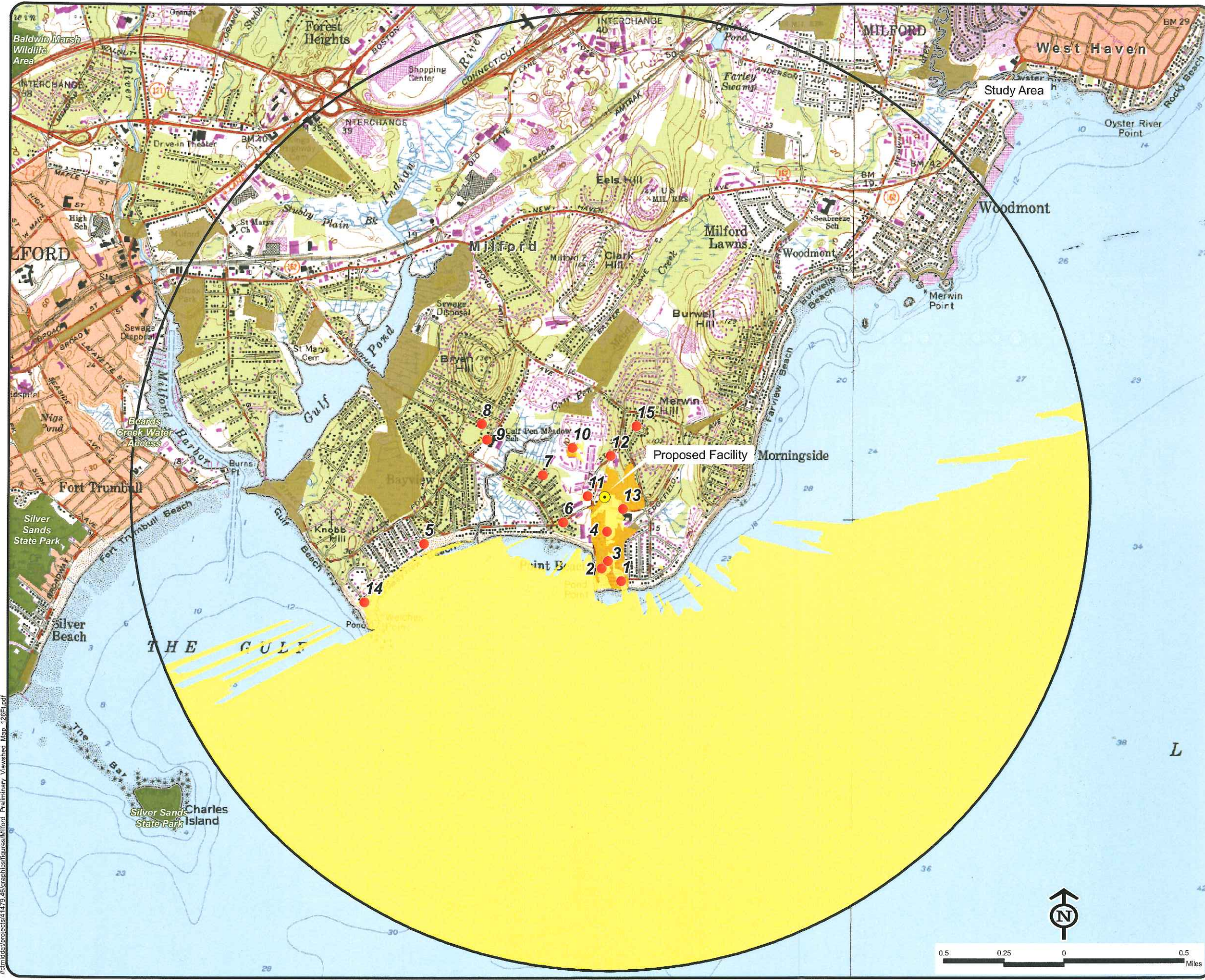
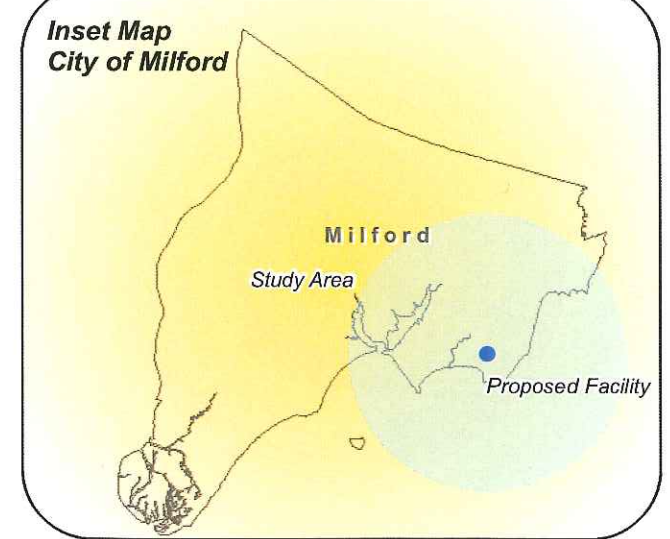

 - Existing tree canopy height estimated at 50 feet.
