POST HEARING SUPPLEMENTAL

As discussed at the October 11, 2011 hearing on Docket 420, this supplemental is provided as clarification to testimony provided by Applicants' witnesses regarding site funding and construction. By way of context, when AT&T originally evaluated the candidate C facility at Cossaduck Road, it was deemed part of a two site solution which would also utilize a colocation on the existing Glasgo Road Tower to the north. Subsequent review including isolation coverage plots provided at the request of the Siting Council showed that candidate C's coverage footprint would in fact be similar to that of candidate A, a one site solution, and may not require a co-location on the existing tower to the north. If approved, post installation evaluation of a the performance of a facility at candidate C, with full foliage, and other evaluative measures would inform AT&T as to the need for a site to the north.

As noted in the testimony in this proceeding, the decision on when to build a needed site depends on several factors. While overall commitment to a needed site does not change, actual budgeting and timing for construction may change over time depending in part on the performance of surrounding sites and the network in the general area.
