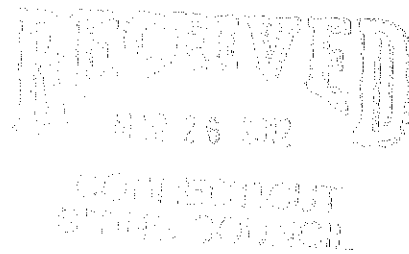

Hi Bob - I looked into the visitation at Black Rock Lake. There is a traffic counter at the damsite but it only counts cars during the spring/summer/fall months. When the damsite is closed to traffic during the winter, folks will park outside of the area and usually walk in. This number of walk-ins is estimated.

For fiscal year 2011, the visitation at the damsite only was estimated at approximately 3,161 visitors and not the 6,400 I originally mentioned to you in our prior conversation. This number amounts to roughly 5% of the total visitation at the damsite. Total FY11 visitation for the entire project was approximately 64,000 visitors.

You had made mention that you wanted me to send this information to the Siting Council. I cannot do that. As you are the intervener in the cell tower process you will need to provide this information to them.

For the record, as the proposed cell tower is not on Corps property, the Corps has no opinion on the proposed cell tower and it will have no effect on Corps missions.

If I can be of further assistance please let me know.
