The State Historic Preservation Office previously issued a comment letter for a proposed telecommunications facility at "936 Linkfield Road" in Watertown, Connecticut¹. It is our understanding that the address of the proposed facilities in the materials submitted to this office was incorrect. The facilities will be constructed at 655 Bassett Road in Watertown. Infinigy has informed SHPO that all other information used by SHPO in our evaluation of the potential effects of this undertaking on historic properties was correct.

Based on the supplemental information that you have submitted to this office, SHPO reiterates our previous opinion: we expect that the proposed undertaking will have <u>no effect</u> on historic, architectural, or archaeological resources listed on or eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

This office appreciates the opportunity to have reviewed and commented upon the proposed undertaking. This comment is provided in accordance with the National Historic Preservation Act and supersedes all previous correspondence regarding the proposed undertaking.
