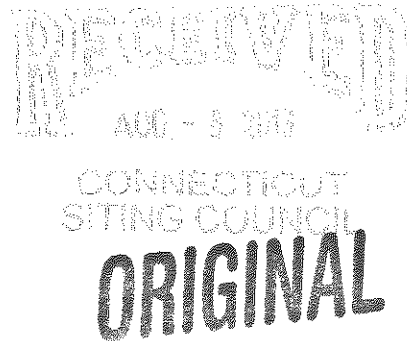


On behalf of North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (“AT&T”), please accept this letter regarding the captioned Facility for which the Siting Council issued a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need in Docket 422 (“Certificate”).

Condition 7 of the Decision and Order dated May 10, 2012 required the approved facility to be fully constructed and providing wireless services within eighteen months from the date of the mailing of the Council’s Findings of Fact, Opinion, and Decision and Order.

Construction commenced on the Facility and AT&T’s portion of the project will be commencing shortly. We are advised that current scheduling demands and logistical considerations for AT&T will push final completion and the anticipated on-air date past November 10, 2013. Accordingly, we respectfully request a six month extension of the completion time to May 31, 2014 which will give AT&T sufficient time to complete construction and bring the Facility on air.
