In Woodstock, Connecticut. The property being considered for the proposed wireless telecommunications facility ("Facility") is an approximately 128 acre parcel located on the western side of Route 198, and identified as Map 5789, Block 37 Lot 24. 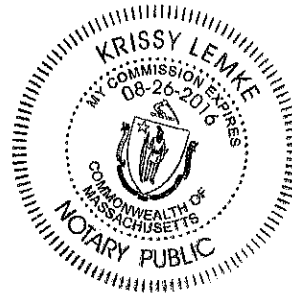
