

RE: **DOCKET NO. 424** - The Connecticut Light & Power Company application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need for the Connecticut portion of the Interstate Reliability Project that traverses the municipalities of Lebanon, Columbia, Coventry, Mansfield, Chaplin, Hampton, Brooklyn, Pomfret, Killingly, Putnam, Thompson, and Windham, which consists of (a) new overhead 345-kV electric transmission lines and associated facilities extending between CL&P's Card Street Substation in the Town of Lebanon, Lake Road Switching Station in the Town of Killingly, and the Connecticut/Rhode Island border in the Town of Thompson; and (b) related additions at CL&P's existing Card Street Substation, Lake Road Switching Station, and Killingly Substation.

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At the evidentiary hearing for the above referenced proceeding held on June 26, 2012, the Connecticut Siting Council (Council) considered and ruled on the motions/requests as follows:

1. The Council granted The Connecticut Light and Power Company (CL&P) Request for the Council to Take Administrative Notice of the study, "Electric and Magnetic Field Exposure Assessment of Powerline and Non-powerline Sources for Public School Environments."
2. The Council denied CL&P's Motion for Protective Order with Respect to Mount Hope Underground Variation – in ROW Cost Estimate Details.
3. Lastly, the Council granted CL&P's Preliminary Request to Postpone the hearing scheduled for June 28, 2012.

Continued evidentiary hearing dates have been scheduled for Tuesday, July 31, 2012 and Thursday, August 2, 2012, in Room 313 at the Institute of Technology and Business Development, Central Connecticut State University (CCSU), 185 Main Street, in New Britain, beginning at 11:00 a.m. The Council directs that all testimony and exhibits be pre-filed with the Council and all parties and intervenors by July 17, 2012.


