Pursuant to General Statutes § 16-50o(b), " Λ copy of the transcript of testimony at the hearing shall be filled at an appropriate public office, as determined by the Council, in each county in which the facility or any part thereof is to be located."

The Council has determined that the Town Clerk's Office in the Lebanon Town Hall is an appropriate public office for filing a copy of the transcripts in New London County.
