Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after January 6, 2012 by Message Center Management, Inc. (MCM) for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction, maintenance and operation of a replacement

wireless telecommunications facility in Redding, Connecticut. The property being considered for the proposed replacement wireless telecommunications facility ("Facility") is located at 4 Dittmar Road, and identified as Map 1, Lot 10. The proposed MCM replacement telecommunications facility would be located in the same location of an existing lattice tower already in place on the 5.58 acre parcel. MCM has proposed a new self-supporting monopole tower with stealth features to resemble an evergreen tree (commonly referred to as a "monopine") with a height of 127' above grade level ("AGL").

The tower itself would be expandable structurally to 147' to allow shared use of the structure above or below by other FCC wireless carriers or any public entities. The site and will consist of the 127-foot self-supporting monopole tower, antennas and a 10' x 20' concrete pad within the expanded tower compound. The entire compound would be enclosed by an 8' foot high wood slat fence surrounded by a new/proposed evergreen screening. Vehicle access to the Facility will be provided using the existing driveway. Utility connections that are already in place would be maintained and the existing multimeter bank upgraded as necessary.

The location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

The Facility is being proposed to allow T-Mobile to provide service in this area of the Town. The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed Facility.

A balloon, representative of the proposed height of the tower, will be flown at the proposed site on the first day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the Town, or such other date specified by the Siting Council and a time to be determined by the Siting

Council, but anticipated to be between the hours of 1 pm and 5 pm. Interested parties and residents of the Town of Redding, Connecticut are invited to review the Application during normal business hours after January 6, 2012, at any of the following offices:
