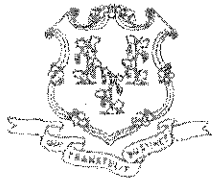

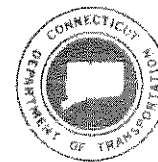

The Department of Transportation (DOT) has reviewed the above-mentioned docket and offers the following comment.

The proposed project results in a curb cut and underground utility work on State route 142 within the state right of way, therefore North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC must attain a Highway Encroachment Permit in conjunction with the Connecticut General Statues prior to performing any work within the right of way. The District 3 Permit Office will need review four complete sets of construction plans which show all work within the State highway right of way, all site work, any required easements and standard details for highway construction prior to issuing the encroachment permit.

The District 3 Permit Office will determine the bond amount, insurance coverage, maintenance and protection of traffic, inspection, roadway restoration and pavement restoration requirements.
