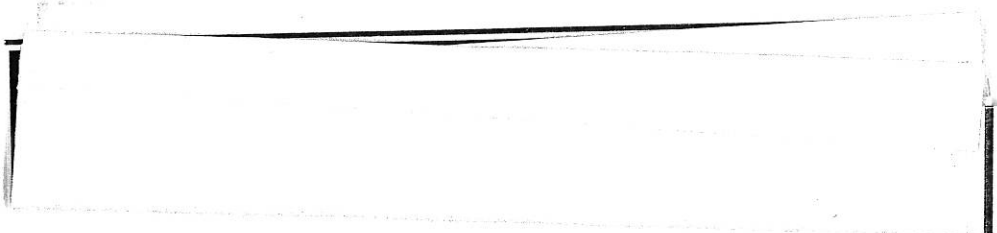

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Section 16-50I(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes and Section 16-50I-1(e) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies of an Application to be filed with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after April 23, 2012 by North Atlantic Towers, LLC and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC ("AT&T") for a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need for the construction and maintenance of a wireless telecommunications facility ("Facility") to be located in Branford or East Haven, Connecticut. The Facility is being proposed to allow AT&T to provide service in the areas of western Branford and eastern East Haven. The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed Facility. Two (2) candidate locations are being considered; however only one location is needed and only one Facility will be constructed.

One candidate is located at 171 Short Beach Road in the Town of Branford, an approximately 0.87 acre parcel owned by 171 Short Beach Road Realty. At this candidate location, the proposed Facility will consist of a 120' monopole and associated unmanned equipment within a 2,500 square-foot fenced compound in the north-west portion of the parcel designed to accommodate the unmanned equipment in either single-story equipment buildings or on concrete pads. Vehicular access to the Facility will extend from Short Beach Road along the existing driveway.

The other candidate is located at 82 Short Beach Road in the Town of East Haven, an approximately 0.91 acre parcel owned by the Riverside Volunteer Fire Department. At this candidate location, the proposed Facility would consist of a 103' monopole and associated unmanned equipment within a 2,500 square-foot fenced equipment compound located in the south-western portion of the parcel designed to accommodate the unmanned equipment in either single-story equipment buildings or on concrete pads. Vehicle access to the Facility will extend from Short Beach along the western side of the existing parking lot.

The Facility will be available for co-location by other wireless carriers. The final location, height and other features of the proposed Facility are subject to review and potential change under provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes Sections 16-50g et. seq.

Balloons, representative of the proposed Facility height, will be flown at 120' above grade level (AGL) at the Branford candidate location and to 103' AGL at the East Haven candidate location on the day of the Siting Council public hearing on the Application, which will take place in the Towns, or on such other date specified by the Siting Council and a time to be determined by the Siting Council, but anticipated to be between the hours of 12pm and 5pm.




