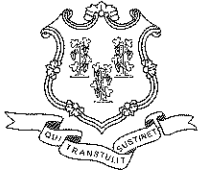
Dear Attorney Ainsworth:

1. During the Town's internal discussion regarding potential telecommunications sites for the Short Beach area, did the Town consider the two large apartment building complex parcels north of the Branford Site at #43 and #61 Briarwood Lane (complexes served by Dover Court and Sunset)? If not, would the Town support the investigation/placement of a tower telecommunications facility on these parcels?
2. On page 39 of the 2008 Town of Branford Conservation and Development Plan, the Community Character Plan, scenic vistas and scenic points are shown. Are these Town designated scenic resources or suggested scenic areas? Have any areas been designated as scenic by the Town since 2008? If so, please provide their locations.
